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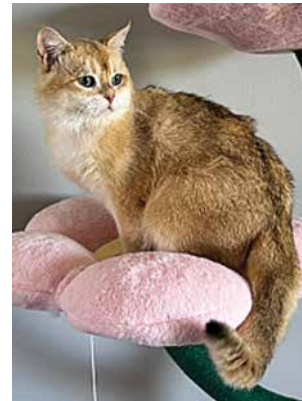

SPOKANE VALLEY CITY COUNCIL | TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2026 | MEETING RECAP

This week’s Spokane Valley City Council meeting began with the pledge of allegiance and approval of the following meeting agenda.

PROCLAMATIONS

Mayor Padden presented proclamations for Good Neighbor Day to members of the Spokane Valley United Methodist Church and for Valleyfest to Peggy Doering.

SPECIAL GUEST PRESENTATION

Preston McCollam, Spokane County Prosecutor, addressed the Council regarding the Spokane County Prosecutor’s Office to review data and discuss challenges.

General Public Comments

Each week, community members have an opportunity to address Councilmembers for up to three minutes during the General Public Comment period, either at the beginning or end of each meeting, either in person or via Zoom.

ACTION ITEMS

#1 – Consent Agenda

The Council approved a motion to consider the 2026 Opportunity Fund Application separately. A motion to approve the Spokane Sports Opportunity Fund grant application (TPAOF 2026-001) was passed with 6 votes in favor and 1 against.

A motion to approve the remaining items of the consent agenda, including vouchers for paying city expenses, payroll and setting a public hearing date for the 2027 budget, passed unanimously.

#2 – 30-Year Easement from State Parks for Flora Road

This item was presented to the Council as an administrative report at the Sept. 8, 2026, meeting. In 2020, the City purchased 46 acres of undeveloped land located on the north bank of the Spokane River at Flora Road from the Washington State Department of Transportation for park and recreation purposes. The City developed the property into The Course Spokane Valley cross country racing facility, completed in 2025. The city-owned parcels are adjacent to a 16-acre parcel owned by State Parks. Part of the development plans for the new park facility included a commitment from State Parks to partner with the City to incorporate the shoreline property into the park, improving public access to the Spokane River and expanding recreational uses for the community.

City staff and State Parks staff collaborated on a plan for the “River View Trail”, which sits on both City and State Parks properties. Staff outlined terms of a proposed 30-year easement agreement between the two entities. The terms of the agreement require the City to pay State Parks a one-time lump sum of \$58,194 for the 30-year easement. On July 9, 2026, the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission unanimously

approved the easement as well as land classification updates and development of the pedestrian trail with various amenities.

A motion to authorize the City Manager to execute a 30-year Easement Agreement with Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission in substantially the same form as shown in the attached document passed with 6 votes in favor and 1 vote against.

#3 – 2027 Council Goals and Priorities for Lodging Tax Advisory Committee

The Council previously discussed this topic at the Sept. 15, 2026, meeting. Per SVMC 3.20.010, the City collects a 3.3% tax on lodging (hotel/ motel room rentals) within Spokane Valley. The Lodging Tax Advisory Committee (LTAC) evaluates applications from organizations for this grant funding and develops recommendations for the Council. The Council is responsible for setting goals and priorities for the LTAC to consider when evaluating the applications.

A motion to approve Council goals and priorities for the use of lodging tax revenues as written passed with 5 votes in favor and 2 votes against.

#4 – 2026 Justice Assistance Grant

This topic was discussed as the Sept. 15, 2026, Council meeting. The Department of Justice annually awards JAG grants to local jurisdictions nationwide for various criminal justice purposes. This year, the City will receive \$30,978 in JAG funds. The Spokane Valley Police Chief has recommended utilizing the grant allocation towards the purchase of a new motorcycle. The total cost for a motorcycle is \$43,470. The approximate \$12,500 cost difference will be covered by the SVPD Traffic Designated Unreserved Fund from DUI restitution. By using JAG and SVPD monies, the City will not need to fund the purchase of a motorcycle in 2028.

A motion to have the City Manager, or designee, apply for and use Justice Assistance Grant funds for a motorcycle purchased passed unanimously.

NON-ACTION ITEMS

#5 – Proposed Property Tax Ordinance

The Council has discussed this 2027 property tax levy multiple times during the 2027 budget development process. State law requires the passage of an ordinance establishing a property tax levy. The proposed 2027 property tax levy does not include the 1% increase allowed by State law. The levy will include property taxes on new construction.

Staff shared an overview of Washington State property taxes and the different taxing jurisdictions reflected on tax statements sent to property owners by the Spokane County Assessor. As an example, the following is the distribution of property taxes in the city’s largest property tax district (TCA 144):

- 37% Central Valley School District

- 24% Spokane Valley Fire District No. 01
- 21% State schools
- 8% City of Spokane Valley
- 7% Spokane County
- 3% Spokane County Library District

The group discussed the estimated rate per \$1,000 of assessed value, the Senior and Disabled Property Tax Exemption Program, banked capacity, and estimated property tax revenues. This item will return before the Council at the Oct. 6, 2026, and Oct. 20, 2026, meetings, at which time the Council will consider first and second readings of the 2027 Property Tax Ordinance.

#6 – Spokane Valley Police Department (SVPD) Update

SVPD Chief Dave Ellis provided an overview of current police department activities. He spoke about:

- Crime trends: 2025 results and 2026 year-to-date activity
- Retail theft emphasis: Participating businesses and enforcement results
- My90 community feedback: Public perceptions and safety priorities
- Operation Stampede: U.S. Marshals Service partnership and operation results
- Community engagement efforts: Coffee with a Cop and Cops and Kids Car Show
- Shop with a Cop: Back-to-School events with local children

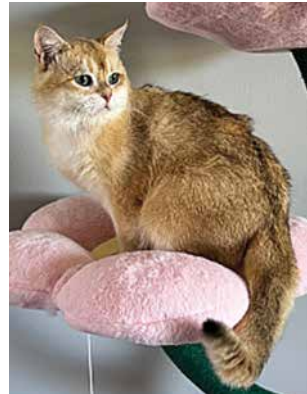

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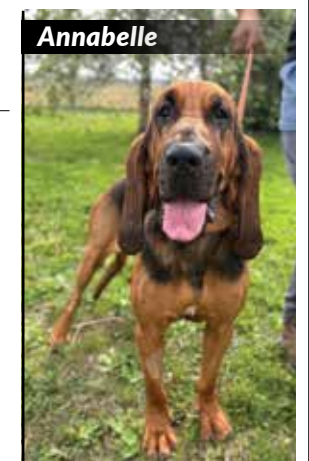

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Dave Graybill
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I am looking forward to some really fun fishing. My daughter is coming over from Seattle, and we are going to fish for smallmouth bass on Banks Lake, and then fish for rainbow and bass on Lake Roosevelt. I plan to take some other family that haven't been out with me for a while, and we are going to take advantage of the good weather and have a blast.

Anglers throughout the region are watching the fish counts at McNary Dam and planning trips to chase Chinook salmon in the Hanford Reach. Fall Chinook are passing over the dam at three to four thousand a day now, and it won't be long before they show up in "fishable" numbers. The Columbia River from White Bluffs to Priest Rapids Dam will be crowded with boats for the most popular and productive salmon season in the region. For several years I spent a few days at "Fish Camp", where writers and broadcasters like me were gathered at Biggs, Washington. Each day we got to fish for salmon off the mouth of the Deschutes or Klickitat rivers, or Drano Lake. I also enjoyed topwater fishing for smallmouth bass. The salmon fishing was very good for bright Chinook, and the smallmouth fishing was spectacular. There are more and more anglers traveling to this area on the Columbia to get these bright fish before they arrive in the Hanford Reach. There is great access to the water on both the Washington and Oregon sides of the river and plenty of places to stay and dine while there. I always enjoyed it.

I mentioned that I have enjoyed fishing in the fall in different areas of the Columbia, and I have done several videos with Shane Magnuson over the years that thousands of anglers have viewed on the Dave Graybill YouTube channel. Shane was always willing to take me along and share his expertise, and although these were done years ago, they still have value today. I wanted to tell you how to find these instructional videos as a way to "tune up" for your fall fishing adventures. If you go to the Dave Graybill YouTube channel and search under Fishing Fall Kings at Drano Lake, you will find one that is very timely, as that fishery is going right now. If you are planning

to fish the Hanford Reach, there are three videos that you can watch. "Fall Kings at Vernita with Shane Magnuson" features fishing with eggs in this episode. "Using Eggs at Vernita with Shane Magnuson" provides even more information on egg fishing for kings in the Reach. "Fall Salmon at Vernita with Shane Magnuson" is another video worth watching. I want to thank Shane again for helping me provide great information to all of you!

Many people consider the fall months the best of the year to be outdoors. The temperatures are very pleasant, and here in Eastern Washington and Northern Idaho we are treated to many sunny days, with clear skies and no wind. One of my favorite plac-



es to visit in the fall is only about 20 miles from my home in Leavenworth. Fish Lake offers very good fishing for trout, triploid rainbow and kokanee in the fall, and perch are abundant in the lake. I have also caught some very nice largemouth on Fish Lake into October. It's a great place to observe bald eagles and ospreys, that will often swoop down and pick up fish off of the surface of the lake. I have also watched otters playing along the shore, and they are known to steal fish off the stringers of dock anglers. Another reason I like to visit this lake is the incredible bloom of fall colors. The bright yellows, oranges and red colors of the trees that line the shore begin to appear now and become even more brilliant into the fall. It's a place that reminds me of just how wonderful it can be outdoors this time of year.

The steelhead limit on the Tucannon River hatchery steelhead has been reduced. Beginning earlier this month, the limit was reduced to one fish per day, from the mouth to the Tucannon

River Hatchery Road Bridge. The WDFW reminds anglers that barbless hooks are required in this fishery. The reason for the reduction is that the total steelhead return at Bonneville Dam is now 61,500 fish, which would be the lowest total return on record. The total includes 53,400 A-index steelhead, of which 17,500 are unclipped, and 8,100 B-index steelhead, of which 2,900 are unclipped. While the overall return is low, current return estimates for natural- and hatchery-origin steelhead are high enough to allow for some recreational fisheries to continue with reduced daily limits. Anglers are required to cease fishing once they have retained their daily limit. Two pole fishing is not allowed during this fishery. Coho and Chinook may be present during this fishery and must be released, without being removed from the water. The daily limit on steelhead on The Snake River has also been reduced to one fish per day, also due to the anticipated record low return.

I had a great time on Saturday, September 12th at an event that took place at the Rathdrum City Park at the invitation of the Northwest Guardian Riders. This group has many programs that benefit veterans and they also support a variety of programs that benefit the community of Rathdrum. They wanted to stage something that would attract youth to get them interested in fishing. Too many kids don't get the chance to get outdoors and enjoy fishing, and they had organizations like Healing Waters there and Dan Plummer brought his bass boat. I took the Mark's Marine Thunder Jet Luxor and parked near him to show the kids the boat and how to tie a knot and give them some souvenir buttons and lures to take home. There were many members of the Northwest Guardian Riders on hand, and they cooked up hotdogs and burgers and had a fun "duck river" to raise funds. I was able to visit with some of them and hear something about their experiences with their community support activities. They are planning to repeat Saturday's effort to coincide with another popular fishing event for kids in the spring. I look forward to being at that one, too. 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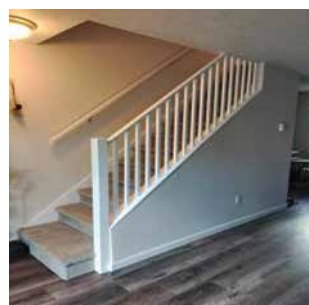


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asbestos is still being used in some building products that
can be found at local hardware stores. Some of the every-
day products that may contain asbestos include roofing
shingles, roofing felt, roof patching compound, cement
siding, drywall and drywall mud, vinyl and asphalt floor
tiles, and mastic adhesives for vinyl floors and carpeting.

Why is asbestos dangerous? Prolonged inhalation of
asbestos fibers can cause serious and fatal illnesses such
as mesothelioma, lung cancer, asbestosis, and pleural dis-
ease or inflammation of the tissues surrounding the lungs.
As early as the 1900s, researchers began to notice a large
number of premature deaths and lung problems in asbes-
tos-mining towns. But it is not just a problem of the past;
asbestos exposure continues to cause over 12,000 deaths
each year in the United States.

Asbestos is a naturally occurring silicate mineral com-
posed of long, thin, microscopic fibrous crystals. It was
first used more than 4,000 years ago when the Greeks and
Romans discovered that it was resistant to fire and heat. It
has been used since then for a wide range of purposes. The
word asbestos comes from the ancient Greek word mean-
ing "unquenchable" or "inextinguishable."

There are now many federal regulations concerning the
handling of asbestos-containing materials, particularly
when they are removed from commercial or public build-
ings during demolition or remodeling projects. When such
materials are classified as "friable," they may fall under
federal regulations. Generally, friable asbestos-containing
material is material that can be crumbled, pulverized, or
reduced to powder by the pressure of an ordinary human
hand. This is particularly dangerous because the fibers
can become airborne and easily inhaled into the lungs.
Once released by such crumbling, asbestos fibers are light
enough to remain suspended in the air for hours or even
days, long after other dust from the project has settled. A
simple cotton face mask is not sufficient protection against
these microscopic particles. Breathing in tiny particles of
asbestos is what can make people sick, even though symp-
toms may not appear for decades.

Asbestos abatement can be extremely expensive because
of the careful and tedious process required for safe re-
moval. In non-commercial structures, such as residential
dwellings, homeowners may not be subject to all of the
same regulations that apply to commercial projects. How-
ever, the health risks associated with asbestos exposure are
no less significant when working on DIY projects around

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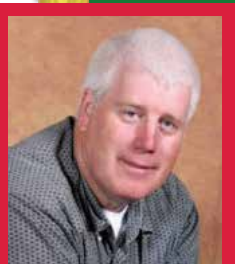

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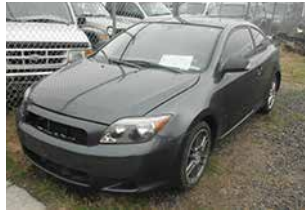

ANDREW TATE WINS BILL MUNCEY CUP, CONCLUDES 2026 SEASON WITH 3-PEAT CHAMPIONSHIP

SAN DIEGO (Sept. 20, 2026) — There will be no need to repaint or renumber the BWR Racing unlimited hydroplane over the winter as Andrew Tate made sure of that last Sunday on Mission Bay.

Tate and the U-1 BWR Racing capped off the 2026 H1 Unlimited season in championship fashion Sunday at Bayfair in San Diego, winning the Bill Muncy Cup and securing the National High Points Championship.

Tate entered the final from lane 3 and delivered when it mattered most, taking the U-1 to victory with an average speed of 152.956 mph. J. Michael Kelly finished second aboard the U-00 Maverick at 147.331 mph, followed closely by Corey Peabody and the U-3 Tahoe Miss at 147.287 mph. Jamie Nilsen and the U-11 Miss FLAV-R-PAC finished fourth.

Jimmy Shane in the U-27 Miss Apollo and Dylan Runne in the U-40 Bucket List Racing were disqualified for N2 violations. According to the internet, "An N2 violation in unlimited hydroplane racing happens when a turbine-powered boat's engine exceeds 110% of the maximum N2 RPM limit for more than five consecutive seconds.

Sunday's victory also sealed another major accomplishment for Tate, who earns his third consecutive H1 Unlimited National High Points Driver Championship and the fourth of his career.

BWR Racing also successfully defended its title, earning its second consecutive National High Points Team Championship.

After a season-long battle that came down to the final day of racing in San Diego, Tate and BWR Racing leave Bayfair with both the Bill Muncy Cup and the 2026 National High Points Championship, bringing the H1 Unlimited season to a close.
