Roosevelt Elementary School

Construction of the Roosevelt Elementary School, located at First and Wallace, began in the summer of 1905, but was not completed in time for the opening of school in September. Students that were expected to attend the new school had to stay at home until the building was ready for use and that did not occur until the 24th of September. In addition to a late start, the chairs and desks for the school did not arrive until the middle of October. When classes finally got under way there were 162 students enrolled at the school with only three teachers.
